

## Did you know??

Arizona tax law offers a tax credit for contributions made to certain charities that provide assistance to the working poor. Arizona Brainfood is one of these charities. The maximum amount of this credit is \$1,000 for married taxpayers and \$500 for individuals.

## How the QCO Tax Credit Works\*

(Qualifying Charitable Organization Tax Credit program)

Anyone who pays state taxes may be eligible for the QCO Tax Credit, which, unlike a deduction, reduces your state income tax bill dollar-for-dollar. For example: if you owe \$1,000 in state income tax, and you donate \$800, you may subtract the \$800 from your tax bill and pay the state only \$200.

The Arizona QCO Tax Credit can be taken in addition to the Private and Public School Tax credits offered by Arizona!

**New from 2018**: Donors are now required to use **QCO Code #20063** when taking tax credit for their donation to AzBrainfood on their income tax returns. Please retain this portion for your records.
