



Did you know??

Arizona tax law offers a tax credit for contributions made to certain charities that provide assistance to the working poor. Arizona Brainfood is one of these charities. The maximum amount of this credit for 2023 is \$841 for married taxpayers and \$421 for individuals.

How the QCO Tax Credit Works* (Qualifying Charitable Organization Tax Credit program)

Anyone who pays state taxes may be eligible for the QCO Tax Credit, which, unlike a deduction, reduces your state income tax bill dollar-for-dollar. For example: if you owe \$1,000 in state income tax, and you donate \$800, you may subtract the \$800 from your tax bill and pay the state only \$200.

The Arizona QCO Tax Credit can be taken in addition to the Private and Public School Tax credits offered by Arizona!

New from 2018: Donors are now required to use **QCO Code #20063** when taking tax credit for their donation to AzBrainfood on their income tax returns. Please retain this portion for your records.
